## **NOTICE**

It is to inform all the cadets of our institute that possession / consumption of alcohol / drugs and other abused substances, is illegal in maritime industry as per rules laid down by International Maritime Organization (IMO) / D.G.Shipping (DGS).

A cadet under the influence of drugs / alcohol will not only jeopardize his own career in merchant navy but also damage the reputation of our institute. Therefore, strict action will be taken against the cadets who possess / consume alcohol / drugs in the premises of the institute.

Merchant Navy being a profession of great physical and psychological demand can be unsuitable for cadets who are addicted to drugs. It is therefore necessary that all cadets take this regulation with utmost seriousness.

This is to inform all the cadets that random drug / alcohol testing will be carried out at frequent intervals by the hostel staff / wardens, to ensure that there is no breach in the policy. Samples of urine or blood will be taken and tested in authorized labs.

Cadets who test positive or are guilty of possession / consumption of Drugs / Aløcohol will be suspended/rusticated as per D.G.Shipping guidelines and our policy of "No Alcohol / Drugs" on premises of our institute.
